The parade route is approximately fifteen blocks long (0.75 miles).

Registration takes place at the Fire Station, which is located at 200 S James Street.

All entries must check in between 8 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. The parade will begin punctually at 10 a.m.

The staging area for the parade is in the parking lot of the Grimes Sports Complex, approximately four (4) blocks south of the Fire Station, on the west side of James Street.

The parade travels through an area of Grimes known as the Governors District.

Regarding candy and handouts; these things are allowed, but we ask that you distribute these items to the parade spectators in a safe manner.
